



## Special Scholarships for Students from India International Foundation Programmes

### May 2013 Start – 4 terms

**Tuition Fee: £16,070 – 45% Scholarship – You pay £8,839**

Available to Indian students who:

- are aged 17 or above and
- have achieved a **minimum 70% or above in the Higher Secondary School Certificate**, with minimum 65% in Mathematics and subjects relevant to the chosen Foundation Programme
- have obtained an **IELTS 4.5 overall score**, with no less than 4.0 in any element, or equivalent qualification

### September 2013 Start – 3 terms

**Tuition Fee: £13,450 – 45% Scholarship – You pay £7,398**

Available to Indian students who:

- are aged 17 or above and
- have achieved a **minimum 70% or above in the Higher Secondary School Certificate**, with minimum 65% in Mathematics and subjects relevant to the chosen Foundation Programme
- have obtained an **IELTS 5.0 or IELTS 5.5 overall score** (depending on subject chosen), with minimum 5.0 in Reading & Writing and 4.5 in Listening or equivalent qualification

#### Partner University Special Scholarships

High achieving students from Central College Nottingham can also apply for a variety of scholarships awarded by our partner universities. For example, the **University of Nottingham** offers **2 scholarships of £2000** to Central College Nottingham students progressing to their undergraduate programmes.
